2019 was filled with excitement and growth here at Kitsap Community Foundation. We said goodbye to five-year Communications Officer Ani Gatz, welcomed Anna James Miller to the role, completed our first funding cycle for the new Women's Giving Circle of the Kitsap Peninsula, facilitated our local nonprofits raising over \$1.4M in the Kitsap Great Give, and continued finding new ways to address the root causes of poverty and adversity in our community. Whew! That was a long sentence, but we've been busy.

As we continue our fruitful partnerships with local nonprofits, businesses, and community members, we are now in full swing with our Leave 10 for Kitsap initiative. The central goal of this campaign is to increase giving to Kitsap area nonprofits by encouraging people to leave at least 10% of their estates to local nonprofits. We're running this campaign in partnership with 40 other local nonprofits.

Kitsap Community Foundation is the backbone organization for **Kitsap Strong** - leading our community in building resilience and preventing adverse childhood experiences (ACEs).

- 113 organizations are now involved
- Over 1,594 individuals were taught about ACEs
- Over 58 presentations about ACEs were given
- The WA State Healthy Youth Survey, measuring risk behaviors and social problems among youth, now includes the Children's Hope Scale
- Kitsap County now has a Behavioral Health Court, using a nonadversarial team-based approach, to correct behavior and reduce recidivism.



Kitsap Community Foundation manages and administers **KCNE** (Kitsap Center for Nonprofit Excellence) - providing quality trainings and usable tools that nonprofits can immediately implement.

- 4 workshops - 3 half-day and one full-day
- Average presentation rating of 8.6 out of 10
- 172 individuals attended workshops
- 108 different nonprofits attended workshops
- 29 total members

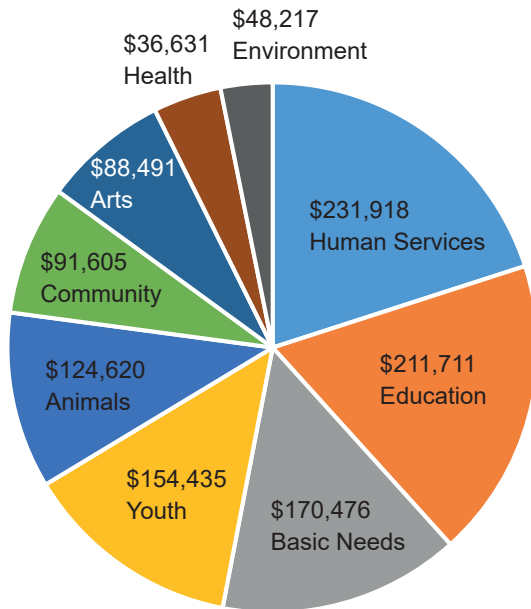

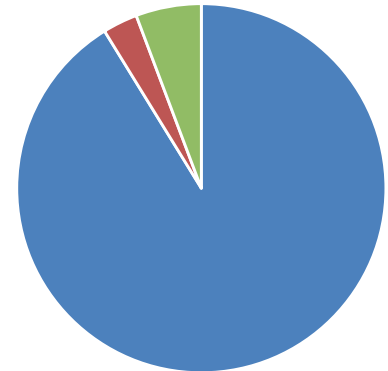

Total Gifts by Nonprofit Category



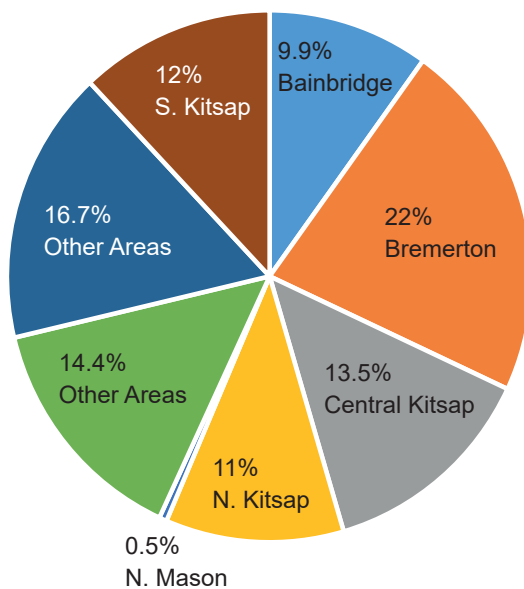

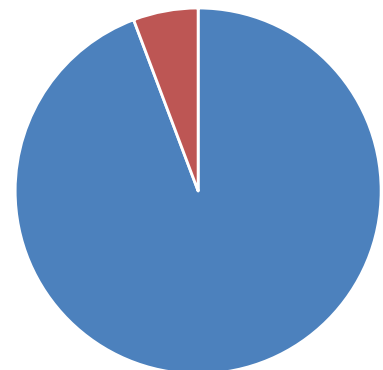

Impacting the Larger System by Sandra Allen, Client Services at Fishline

Over Fishline's 51-year history, we have grown to serve more than 4,000 people each year. Recently, we were inspired by Kitsap Strong to look at our whole agency and ask: Are we trauma-informed? How can we deliver food and services in a trauma-informed way? This approach allows us to focus on how we can help people thrive beyond their current emergency and has impacted our understanding of how Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) impact a person's ability to live a healthy and sustainable life. Kitsap Strong's approach is not only impacting individual lives, but it is impacting the larger system.

Fishline has always focused on a person's dignity, but we went even further as we gained more knowledge about trauma. We now include information about ACEs in our volunteer trainings. We rearranged our lobby

so it feels less like a waiting room and more like a community gathering place. These small shifts had an immediate impact. Volunteers and clients are talking and sharing with each other more. During our appointments, we try and build relationships with our clients. We look beyond their immediate need and we take their history into account. We may have done this intuitively before, but now we do it intentionally, thanks to Kitsap Strong.

For me personally, attending the Kitsap Strong Collaborative Learning Academy (CLA) has been the most impactful training experience of my professional career. I now have working relationships with colleagues from other agencies in my community. I have a deeper understanding of how trauma impacts human development, adulthood decision making, life outcomes, and the power of resiliency. My enthusiasm for my work has increased. I am excited to create programs at Fishline that will allow our clients the opportunity to build resiliency, with the hope of counteracting Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs).

In addition to Fishline's Kitsap Strong participation, Kitsap Community Foundation supports Fishline through an endowed fund, a pass-through fund, donor advised grants, and participation in the annual Kitsap Great Give.

Our Leave 10 for Kitsap initiative is in full swing, helping share the message that leaving a legacy for the next generation is vitally important to our community. Our goal is that together we can inspire others to give where they live and support our local nonprofits in securing bequests from their top supporters.

Since February 2018, we and leaders of several of Kitsap's non-profit organizations have met monthly to plan the Leave 10 for Kitsap program and launched a Leave 10 for Kitsap campaign in early 2019. The campaign provides materials, toolkits, how-tos, and workshops on planned giving, connects non-profits with financial and estate planning professionals, and creates a groundswell of awareness and support to help Kitsap nonprofits include planned giving in their fundraising programs.

The Leave 10 for Kitsap partners are: the Admiral Theatre Foundation, Bainbridge Community Foundation, Boys and Girls Club of South Puget Sound, Bloedel Reserve, Holly Ridge Center, Kitsap Community Foundation, Kitsap Humane Society, Kitsap Regional Library Foundation, Kitsap Rescue Mission, Olympic College Foundation, Martha and Mary, Seabeck Conference Center, and United Way of Kitsap.

Leave 10 for Kitsap is a Kitsap peninsula-wide initiative to increase legacy giving to Kitsap area non-profits by encouraging people to leave 10% of their estates to charity. 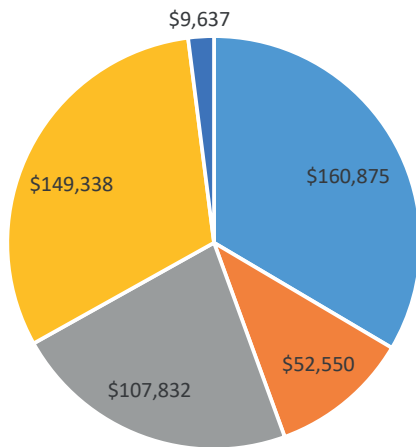


2019 OPERATING INCOME AND EXPENSES ¹

Total Distributed to Nonprofits in 2019 = \$2,230,105.98² Total Inflows = \$3,990,568 Total Outflows = \$3,564,551³

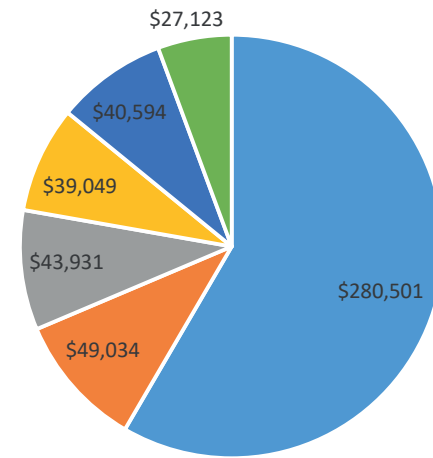

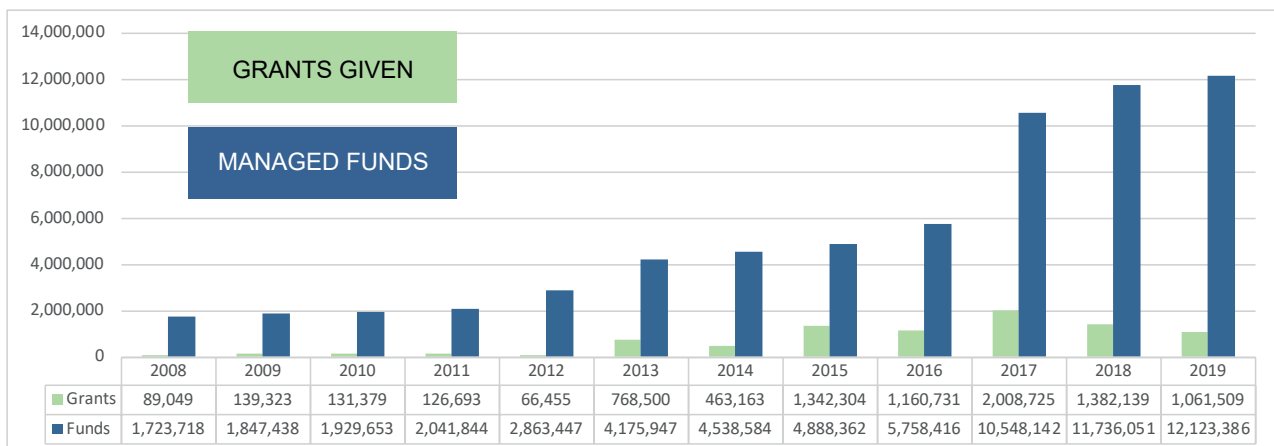
